

Hawridge & Cholesbury Commons - Permissive Rides

Hawridge & Cholesbury Commons are privately owned (by the Lord of the Manors of Hawridge and Cholesbury) and consequently there is no automatic right to ride on the Commons. However, horses may be ridden on certain defined paths which are shown (in red) on the map below. Horses are not allowed on other parts of the Commons. In particular, please note that the ride adjacent to the cricket pitch crosses to the other side of the road to ensure that there is no encroachment on the outfield. It will be appreciated if all riders would keep to the specified rides.

So that the rides retain their permissive status, they are closed to riders for one day during the year - the first Monday in March.
